**Sister M. Rosae Brown, SSND**  
*First Profession - July 17, 1962 | Celebrating 60 Years*



**Sister M. Rosae Brown** was born in Strasburg, North Dakota, and in 1962 professed first vows in Mankato, Minnesota. In 1964 she received a bachelor's degree in English from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. She spent the first 16 years of her ministry in education, teaching at St. Martin, Rogers, Minnesota; St. Pius, St. Pius, North Dakota; St. Mary, Madelia, Minnesota; St. John Nepomucene, Winona, Minnesota; Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph, Raymond, Iowa; Project Discovery, St. Paul, Minnesota; and Epiphany, Coon Rapids, Minnesota. Sister Rosae felt a call to minister in nursing, so beginning in 1980 she served as a nurse's aide at Trevilla of Robbinsdale, Robbinsdale, Minnesota, for six years. She studied at Presentation College, Aberdeen, South Dakota, from 1986 to 1988 and received an associate's degree in nursing. During the late 1980s to the mid-2000s she was a registered nurse at Prince of Peace Hospital, Sioux Falls, South Dakota, and at St. Otto's Care Center, Little Falls, Minnesota. She served as a health care provider at Moravian Care Ministries, Waconia, Minnesota, for one year before serving as a registered nurse at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota, until 2011. Sister Rosae spent one year at the former St. Mary of the

Pines, Chatawa, Mississippi, as a registered nurse before returning to Our Lady of Good Counsel where she has been serving as a registered nurse since 2015.
