First Profession - July 30, 1962 | Celebrating 60 Years



Sister Mary Ann Carey was born in St. Louis and professed first vows there in 1962. In 1964 she received a bachelor's degree in art and English from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis. That same year she began teaching at St. Peter Grade School, Jefferson City, Missouri, where she remained for six years. From 1970 to 1976 she taught at Holy Angels Elementary School in East St. Louis, Illinois. She then began teaching and serving as primary coordinator at Our Lady of Loretto, Spanish Lake, Missouri. In 1981 Sister Mary Ann received a master's degree in reading education from Clarke College (now University), Dubuque, Iowa. After teaching at Our Lady of Loretto for six years, she went to St. Mary, Alton, Illinois, where she taught for six years. Starting in 1988 Sister Mary Ann spent the next 12 years as a teacher and reading specialist at St. Ignatius Loyola, Concord Hill, Missouri. She began the 2000s as a teacher at St. Theodore, Flint Hill, Missouri. In 2003 she began teaching at Sacred Heart, Rich Fountain, Missouri, and currently serves there as the school's art teacher and the parish's religion teacher.
