A memory I have to share...

When I first began teaching, I recall how excited and eager I was for school to start and to finally meet my students! Now that first enthusiasm has mellowed and deepened as I daily continue to go about the mission of Jesus.

Sister Susan Hetebrueg is originally from West Bend, Wisconsin, and in 1962 made first profession in Mequon, Wisconsin. After professing first vows Sister Susan taught for six years at St. Mary, Burlington, Wisconsin. During this time she received a bachelor's degree in social studies from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. In 1977 she received a master's degree in reading education from Cardinal Stritch University, Milwaukee. Throughout the 1970s and early 1980s Sister Susan taught in Wisconsin schools, including St. James, Mequon; St. Kilian, Campbellsport; St. Leo, Milwaukee; and St. Mary, West Bend. In 1982 she worked with the team of initial and ongoing formation directors for the former Milwaukee province, serving in this role until 1988. She then went to Minnesota where she served in pastoral ministry, first at St. Mary, Winnebago and then at St. Teresa, Mapleton. During this time she received a master's degree in pastoral studies from Loyola University, Chicago. She returned to Wisconsin in 1995, serving as manager of pastoral care at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove for six years. From 2001 to 2012 Sister Susan was a pastoral associate and director of adult enrichment at Our Lady Queen of Peace, including one year as director of adult enrichment at St. Joseph, both parishes located in Madison, Wisconsin. She then went to Guam, serving in pastoral presence for the Notre Dame community in Talofofo. After returning to

the United States in 2014, she served

as the coordinator of the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults at the six parishes in Sheboygan, Wisconsin. Since 2018 Sister Susan has been serving as community leader, first at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Wisconsin, and now at Trinity Woods, Milwaukee.
