



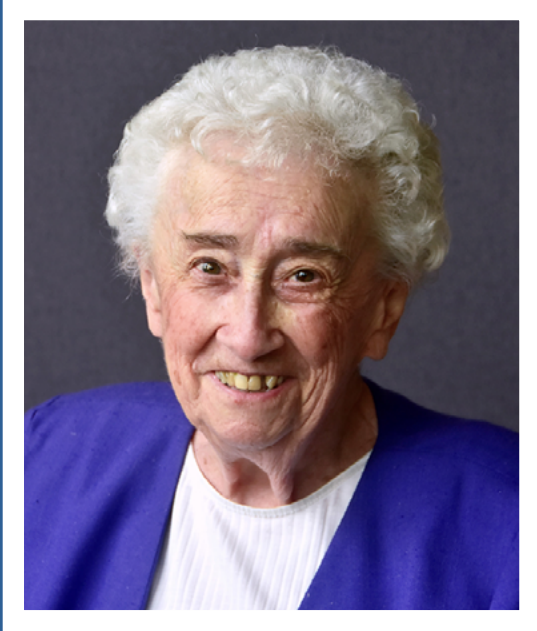

A memory I have to share...

My last years in Minneapolis were spent tutoring math at Menlo Park Academy. Besides math I became aware of the students' lives, who their parents were, safety issues or what life is like in jails and/or detention homes.



Sister Beverly Ann Fries was born in Minneapolis, and in 1952 she made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. She began her ministry in 1953, teaching at St. Albert, Albertville, Minnesota, for one year and St. Leo Catechetical School, Pipestone, Minnesota, for one year. From the mid-1950s to the early 1960s, she was in Washington state teaching at Guardian Angel, Colton and St. Joseph, Spokane. During this time, she earned a bachelor's degree in education from Holy Names College (now University), Oakland, California. From 1962 to 1963 she taught at St. Bartholomew, Wayzata, Minnesota, and from 1963 to 1965 she taught at St. Mary, New Trier, Minnesota. Beginning in 1965 Sister Beverly Ann spent one year in Iowa, teaching at St. Peter, New Haven and then returned to Minnesota where she has remained for the duration of her ministry. From the mid-1960s to the early 1970s, she ministered in Shakopee schools, teaching at St. Mark and teaching and serving as administrator at Shakopee Area Catholic School. In 1971 she received a master's degree in education with a counseling and guidance emphasis from Loras College, Dubuque, Iowa. Sister Beverly taught for a short time at St. Bartholomew, Wayzata before teaching for 30 years at Northeast Regional Catholic School, now

St. John Paul II Catholic School, in Minneapolis. During the 2000s she was a tutor at Menlo Park Academy, Minneapolis and at Loyola Catholic School and the Good Counsel Learning Center, both in Mankato. Sister Beverly Ann currently resides in prayer and presence at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota.
