## Sister Germaine Mulcahey, SSND

*First Profession - July 17, 1952 | Celebrating 70 Years*



**Sister Germaine Mulcahey** was born in Janesville, Minnesota, and in 1952 made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. She began her ministry that same year, teaching at St. Agnes, St. Paul, Minnesota, for one year. During the early years of her ministry, she taught in Minnesota schools, including Immaculate Conception, Lonsdale; St. Andrew, St. Paul; and St. Anne, Wabasso. In 1960 she received a bachelor's degree in education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. Beginning in 1963 she taught for three years at Sacred Heart, Eden, South Dakota, and for one year at St. Benedict School, Strasburg, North Dakota. She returned to Minnesota in 1967 where she has remained, teaching at St. John the Baptist, Searles; St. Peter and Paul, Mankato; St. Joseph the Worker, Mankato; St. Matthew, St. Paul; and St. Joseph School, Rosemount. From 2008 to 2015 she has served as a tutor at the East Side Learning Center, St. Paul, Minnesota. Since 2015 Sister Germaine has resided in prayer, presence and service at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota.
