Sister Jeannette Glinske, SSND *First Profession - July 18, 1952 | Celebrating 70 Years*



Sister Jeannette Glinske was born in Detroit and started her teaching ministry at St. John De La Salle, Chicago in 1950. She remained there until 1951 and then started teaching at St. James, Grand Rapids, Michigan, in 1952. That same year she professed first vows in Milwaukee. In 1959 she received a bachelor's degree in education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. She taught at St. James until 1966 and remained in Michigan for the rest of her ministry, teaching at St. Adalbert, Grand Rapids; teaching and serving as religious education coordinator at Sacred Heart, Grosse Ile; and serving on the secretarial staff at East Catholic High School, Detroit. In 1972 she earned a master's degree in education from Wayne State University, Detroit and in 1978 earned a master's degree in religious studies from the University of Detroit. Since 2008 Sister Jeannette has been serving in prayer and presence, first at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Wisconsin, and now at Our Lady of the Angels, Greenfield, Wisconsin.
