A memory I have to share...

Working with adults in the marriage tribunal was a special ministry for me after being a teacher. What a joy for me to be an advocate for those who need healing. I also cherish my Jubilee trip to Rome.

Sister Muriel Glodosky is originally from Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, and started teaching at All Saints, Chicago in 1950, remaining there for one year. In 1952 she professed first vows in Milwaukee and began teaching at Sts. Peter and Paul, Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin. After two years she went to Sacred Heart, Appleton, Wisconsin, where she taught until 1955. She returned to Chicago in 1956, teaching first at St. John De La Salle and then at St. Helena of the Cross. From 1963 until 1977 Sister Muriel taught in Wisconsin schools, including St. Joachim, Pittsville; St. Francis Xavier, Green Bay; St. Peter, Chippewa Falls; and St. Peter, Beaver Dam. During this time she received a bachelor's degree in education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. From 1977 to 1979 Sister Muriel taught at Sacred Heart, Grand Rapids, Michigan. She taught one year at St. Joseph, Freeport, Illinois, and served as a member of the Diocese of Rockford, Illinois, marriage tribunal for four years. In 1984 she returned to Wisconsin, engaging in community service at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Mount Calvary and serving as coordinator of religious education and in pastoral ministry at St. Peter, Oconto. From 1991 to 1992 Sister Muriel was a member of the local leadership team at Visitation,

Elm Grove, Wisconsin; and at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Mount Calvary, Wisconsin, from 1992 to 1998. Starting in 1999 she served in hospitality ministry for six years. She is currently serving in prayer and presence at Trinity Woods, Milwaukee.
