First Profession - July 31, 1947 | Celebrating 75 Years



Sister Lawrence Marie Brauer was born in Milwaukee and began her ministry in 1946, serving as an elementary school teacher at the Academy of Our Lady School, Chicago. In 1947 she made first profession in Milwaukee and started teaching at St. Francis Xavier, Superior, Wisconsin, remaining there until 1953. She then went to Wauwatosa, Wisconsin, teaching at Christ the King until 1960. That same year Sister Lawrence Marie received a bachelor's degree in English from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. After receiving her degree, she remained in Wisconsin for the duration of her teaching ministry, teaching at St. James, Mukwonago; St. Paul, Bloomer; and St. Aloysius, West Allis. From 1997 to 1998 she served as a receptionist and switchboard operator for the former Milwaukee Province, Elm Grove, Wisconsin, and engaged in community service from 1998 to 2000 at Milwaukee area nursing homes. Sister Lawrence Marie retired in 2000 and spent the later years of her ministry volunteering at Havenwood Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Milwaukee, and ministering to the elderly at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Wisconsin. She currently resides in prayer and presence at Trinity Woods, Milwaukee.
