Sister Maris Stella Waselak, SSND

First Profession - July 15, 1947 | Celebrating 75 Years



Sister Maris Stella Waselak is originally from Minneapolis and in 1947 made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. She spent the first 16 years of her ministry teaching in Minnesota schools, including St. Francis de Sales, St. Paul; John Ireland, St. Peter; St. Peter and Paul, Loretto; St. Matthew, St. Paul; St. Peter and Paul, Mankato; St. Stanislaus, Winona; and St. Anthony, Lismore. In 1958 she received a bachelor's degree in secretarial education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. From 1963 to 1965 Sister Maris Stella taught at Trinity High School, Dickinson, North Dakota, and from 1965 to 1966 taught and was a member of the secretarial staff at Our Lady of Good Counsel Academy, Mankato, Minnesota. She returned to North Dakota in 1966 where she taught at St. Mary, New England for the next six years. In 1972 she came back to Mankato where she served as a staff member for the former Mankato Province at Our Lady of Good Counsel for one year. She was then a member of the secretarial staff for three years and was engaged in community service for one year at Our Lady of Good Counsel Academy. From 1977 to 1987 she served as a receptionist and switchboard operator and from 1987 to 2007 was engaged in community service at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato where she currently resides in prayer and presence.
