Sister Anna Marie Reha was born in Iowa City, Iowa, and in 1983, professed first vows in Mankato, Minnesota. She received a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Mankato State University, Mankato, in 1984. That same year, Sister Anna Marie began her ministry teaching at St. Matthew in St. Paul, Minnesota. She taught at St. Matthew for seven years and then went to Guatemala where she served as pastoral administrator at San Sebastian, San Marcos, from 1992 to 2002. At the same time, she served as director of vocations in Guatemala for the School Sisters of Notre Dame former Mankato Province from 1994 to 1998. In 2005, she received a master's degree in divinity from Oblate School of Theology, San Antonio, and then spent 10 years as the director of Hispanic ministry for the Diocese of New Ulm, Minnesota. Since 2015, Sister Anna Marie has been serving as a provincial councilor for the School Sisters of Notre Dame Central Pacific Province.
