First Profession - July 23, 1983 | Celebrating 40 Years



Sister Elizabeth Ann (Betty) Uchytel is originally from Superior, Wisconsin. She received a bachelor's degree in elementary education from the University of Wisconsin, Superior, Wisconsin, in 1971, and spent nine years teaching for Superior public schools. In 1983, Sister Betty professed first vows in Elm Grove, Wisconsin, and began her ministry teaching and serving as administrator at SS Peter and Paul in Huntington, Indiana. While at SS Peter and Paul, she received a master's degree in administration from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 1985. Starting in 1987, she taught at St. Mary in Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin, remaining there until 1993. For the next six years, Sister Betty was principal at St. Mary in Elm Grove, and then went to Nepal, where she taught at Notre Dame Elementary School, Bandipur, for one year. After returning to the United States in 2001, she was principal at St. Roman Parish School, Milwaukee, for four years before serving as provincial councilor for the former School Sisters of Notre Dame Milwaukee Province for six years. During the 2010s, she was principal at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School in Sheboygan, Wisconsin, and Holy Family in Hannibal, Missouri. Since 2021, Sister Betty has

been serving as a sister donor representative for the School Sisters of Notre Dame Central Pacific Province.
