Sister Gayle Hurban is originally from Cleveland, Ohio, and in 1973, she made first profession in Dallas. Throughout her ministry, she has served as a teacher's aide for Holy Rosary, San Antonio; Chinchuba Institute for the Deaf, Marrero, Louisiana; St. Therese, Jackson, Mississippi; St. Mary, Gainesville, Texas; and Immaculate Conception, Rio Grande City, Texas. She has also served as a kindergarten teacher at St. Anthony, Bunkie, Louisiana, and a primary houseparent at St. Peter-St. Joseph Children's Home, San Antonio. Sister Gayle became certified as an early childhood Montessori teacher in 2001.
