First Profession - July 8, 1973 | Celebrating 50 Years



Sister Linda Marie Bos is originally from Appleton, Wisconsin, and in 1973, she made first profession in Mequon, Wisconsin. She received a bachelor's degree in history and art from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee, in 1975. She began her ministry that same year, teaching at St. Mary in Port Washington, Wisconsin, until 1982. She then taught at St. Gabriel in Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin, until 1986. She returned to Milwaukee to study and teach at Marquette University, receiving a master's degree in history in 1988. She then enrolled in Marquette's doctoral program. In 1992, Sister Linda Marie became a member of Mount Mary College's faculty, and in 1994, she received a doctorate in history. At Mount Mary, she served as an assistant and associate professor and as chair of the history department until 2020. Recently, Sister Linda Marie served as congregational communications coordinator at the School Sisters of Notre Dame Generalate in Rome. She is currently taking time for spiritual development and to discern her next ministry.
