## Sister Mary Ann Osborne, SSND

**Sister Mary Ann Osborne** is originally from St. Peter, Minnesota, and in 1974, she made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota. That same year, she began teaching at Immaculate Conception-St. Joseph in Gilbertville, Iowa. In 1975, she received a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Mount Mary College (now University) in Milwaukee. She taught at Immaculate Conception-St. Joseph until 1977, and then taught at St. Agnes in St. Paul, Minnesota, for two years. From 1979 to 1982, Sister Mary Ann taught and served as boarder supervisor at St. Mary in New England, North Dakota. She then taught for four years at Immaculate Conception in Lonsdale, Minnesota. From 1986 to 1988, she was a student and worker at the Ivan Willock Studio in Faribault, Minnesota, and received a bachelor's degree in art from Metro State University, St. Paul, Minnesota, in 1997. For six months during 1994 to 1995, she studied wood sculpture with Sister Sigmunda May, Order of St. Francis (OSF), in Stuttgart, Germany. Upon her return, she served in hospitality for one year at Our Lady of Good Counsel Education Center, Mankato. Since 1988, Sister Mary Ann has had a wood carving studio at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato.
