## Sister Patricia Gravemann, SSND

**Sister Patricia Gravemann** was born in St. Charles, Missouri, and in 1973, she professed first vows in St. Louis. She received a bachelor's degree in American studies from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis, in 1974. Sister Patricia Gravemann began her ministry teaching at St. Gabriel the Archangel in St. Louis. She taught at St. Gabriel for three years and then became the coordinator of religious education at St. Joseph, Manchester, Missouri. In 1982, she began serving at St. Engelbert in St. Louis, teaching for four years before becoming the school's principal in 1986. While at St. Engelbert, Sister Patricia received a master's degree in elementary education administration from Clarke College (now University), Dubuque, Iowa. In 1989, she became the principal at St. Stephen in Caseyville, Illinois, remaining there until 1995. Sister Patricia then served as principal at Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic School in Caseyville, Illinois, from 1995 to 2003. She is currently the administrator at Sancta Maria in Ripa, St. Louis.
