### *A memory I have to share...*

I appreciate the ministries I was involved in, especially working with adults. With God's grace and love, I learned how to reach out to others. Together we share blessings.

**Sister Dorothy Land** was born in Milwaukee, and she made first profession there in 1963. From 1965 to 1968, she taught at Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary in Sun Prairie, Wisconsin, and then went to St. Nicholas, Milwaukee, where she taught for three years. In 1969, she received a bachelor's degree in English from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. After teaching at St. Nicholas, she went to Notre Dame School in De Pere, Wisconsin, where she taught for five years. She was the coordinator of religious education at Holy Childhood, Harbor Springs, Michigan, for one year and director of religious education at Holy Angels, West Bend, Wisconsin, for six years. In 1978, Sister Dorothy received a master's degree in theology from St. John's University, Collegeville, Minnesota. From the mid-1980s to the mid-1990s, she served as director of religious education at St. Mary, Fond du Lac, Wisconsin; St. Veronica, Milwaukee; and St. Bridget, River Falls, Wisconsin. She also taught at Divine Savior/Holy Angels in Milwaukee and at Mount Mary University in Milwaukee. She was engaged in pastoral ministry at Immaculate Conception Parish, St. Cloud, Minnesota, from 1995 to 1997, and at St. Cecelia Parish, Thiensville, Wisconsin. During the first half of the 2000s, Sister Dorothy served as a personal care assistant at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Mount Calvary, Wisconsin, and as a coordinator of the Ewens Spirituality Center, Mount Mary University,

Milwaukee. From 2004 to 2010, she

former Milwaukee Province. After retiring in 2010, Sister Dorothy was engaged in volunteer ministry, community service and as a driver at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Wisconsin.
