Sister Marcia Mary Zofkie was born in Wapakoneta, Ohio, and in 1963, she professed her first vows in Mequon, Wisconsin. She began her ministry that same year, teaching at Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee, for one year. She then taught at Notre Dame High School, Milwaukee, for one year. In 1965, Sister Marcia Mary received a bachelor's degree in music education from Mount Mary College (now University). After receiving her degree, she went to West Catholic High School, Grand Rapids, Michigan, where she taught for 11 years. In 1971, she received a master's degree in music education from Michigan State University, East Lansing, Michigan. Sister Marcia Mary returned to Milwaukee in 1976, and spent 24 years at Mount Mary University teaching music and serving as music department chairperson. From the late 2000s to the early 2010s, she served at Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Mount Calvary, Wisconsin. Since 2012, Sister Marcia Mary has been serving in prayer and presence, first at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Wisconsin, and now at Our Lady of the Angels in Greenfield, Wisconsin.
