## Sister Anastasia Wehner, SSND

*First Profession - July 31, 1953 | Celebrating 70 Years*



**Sister Anastasia Wehner** is originally from St. Louis, and made first profession there in 1953. She began her ministry that same year, teaching at Blessed Sacrament in Belleville, Illinois, until 1959. She received a bachelor's degree in history from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis, and then went on to teach at St. Bernadette, also in St. Louis. She taught at St. Bernadette for four years before going to St. Dominic Savio in St. Louis. In 1967, she received a master's degree in theology from the University of Notre Dame, South Bend, Indiana. Sister Anastasia taught at St. Dominic Savio until 1969. She then taught, and served as principal, at St. Joseph in Farmington, Missouri. Beginning in 1973, she served as program director assistant for the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau, Springfield, Missouri, where she remained until 1980. During the 1980s, Sister Anastasia was the director of personnel services for the Office of Personnel Service in St. Louis. She also began serving as the director of religious education for St. Joseph in Marion, Illinois, where she remained until 2008. Throughout the 2010s, she was hospitality coordinator at Sancta Maria in Ripa, St. Louis. Since 2020, Sister Anastasia has been serving in prayer and presence and now resides at Anna House, The Sarah Community, Bridgeton, Missouri.
