First Profession - July 31, 1953 | Celebrating 70 Years



Sister Catherine Marie Brandt was born in Chamois, Missouri, and in 1953, made first profession in St. Louis. That same year, she began her ministry teaching at Holy Angels, Kinloch, Missouri. After one year, she went to Freeburg, Illinois, where she taught at St. Joseph for 15 years. While teaching at St. Joseph, Sister Catherine Marie received a bachelor's degree in history from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis. From 1969 to 1986, she taught primary grades at St. Michael, Radom, Illinois; Immaculate Conception, Jackson, Missouri; St. Teresa, Belleville, Illinois; St. Martin, La Mesa, California; St. Joseph, Kimmswick, Missouri; and St. Charles, DuBois, Illinois. She served as a driver at Villa Gesu, St. Louis, for two years before going to St. Michael in Staunton, Illinois, where she served as a teacher for 27 years and in pastoral ministry for five years. Since 2016, Sister Catherine Marie has been serving as a volunteer at St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store in St. Ann, Missouri.
