## Sister Dolores Marie Siebenmorgen, SSND

*First Profession - July 31, 1953 | Celebrating 70 Years*

Sister Dolores Marie Siebenmorgen is originally from Conway, Arkansas, and in 1952, she began teaching at Blessed Sacrament in Belleville, Illinois. She professed first vows in St. Louis in 1953, and then went to California where she taught at Holy Family in San Diego, for nine years. During that time, she received a bachelor's degree in English from the San Diego College for Women, San Diego. From 1962 to 1968, she taught at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Houston. At the end of her tenure at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, she received a master's degree in elementary education administration from Our Lady of the Lake University, San Antonio. Beginning in 1968, Sister Dolores Marie served as principal at St. Alphonsus, McComb, Texas; St. Patrick, Dallas; and Annunciation, Bogalusa, Louisiana. She taught at St. Peter in Fort Worth, Texas, for one year before serving as community coordinator for the School Sisters of Notre Dame former Dallas Province. From 1983 to 1992, Sister Dolores Marie served in pastoral ministry at St. Mary in Gainesville, Texas, and from 1992 to 1999, she was the parish pastoral associate at Holy Family in Abilene, Texas. In 2000, she became the

pastoral associate at Our Lady of Sorrow Parish, Victoria, Texas, serving there for three years. Since 2003, Sister Dolores Marie has been the hospitality coordinator for the School Sisters of Notre Dame Antonina community in San Antonio.
