A memory I have to share...

From first grade to the present moment, our loving God has blessed me with my SSND sisters. My most precious memories are walking the holy ground Blessed Mother Theresa and other SSND women knew, blessing us who follow.

Sister M. Agnes Claire Krogman was born in Lismore, Minnesota. She made first profession in Mankato, Minnesota, in 1953, and spent the next 14 years teaching in the following Minnesota schools: All Saints, Madison Lake; St. Mary, Bellechester; SS. Cyril and Methodius, Minneapolis; St. Mary, Shakopee; St. Mathias, Wanda; and St. Francis, Buffalo. In 1963, she received a bachelor's degree in history from the College of St. Catherine, St. Paul, Minnesota. In 1965, Sister Agnes Claire went to St. Donatus, Iowa, where she taught at St. Donatus School for two years and served as principal for one year. From there, she returned to Minnesota and served as principal at Our Lady of Victory, Lucan; St. Isidore, Litomysl; St. Anthony, Lismore; and St. Peter, Hokah. During this time, she received a master's degree in elementary education from Mankato State University, Mankato, Minnesota. Throughout the 1980s until 1992, she taught middle school students at St. Peter and Paul, Mankato, Minnesota; St. Mary, Caledonia, Minnesota; and All Saints, Madison Lake, Minnesota. After concluding her teaching ministry, Sister Agnes Claire was the coordinator for Meals on Wheels for St. Mary's Home in St. Paul, Minnesota, from 1992 to 1995. She then worked

in parish ministry for 17 years, serving at St. Peter in Hokah, Minnesota, and at St. Patrick in Brownsville, Minnesota. Since 2013, Sister Agnes Claire has been serving in prayer and presence, first at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota, and now at Benedictine Living Community in Shakopee, Minnesota.
