

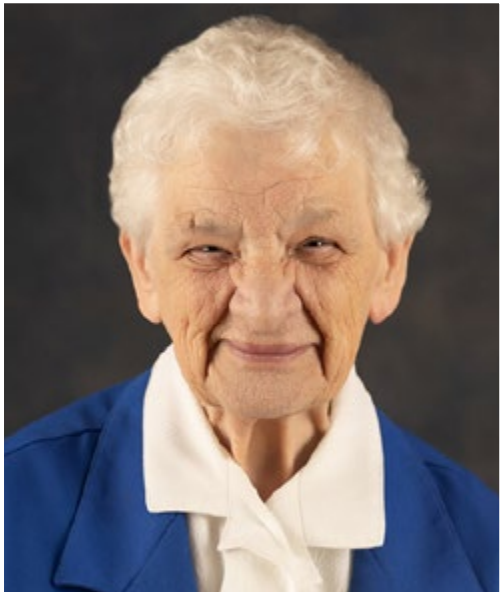

Sister M. Petrann Sieben was born in New Trier, Minnesota. In 1953, she professed first vows in Mankato, Minnesota, and began her ministry teaching at St. Felix in Wabasha, Minnesota. In 1962, she received a bachelor's degree in history from the College of St. Catherine, St. Paul, Minnesota, and in 1973, she received a master's degree in reading education from Mankato State University, Mankato, Minnesota. Early in her ministry, she taught for two years at St. Joseph in Grenville, South Dakota. The remainder of her teaching ministry was spent in Minnesota schools, including St. Matthew, St. Paul; St. John Nepomucene, Winona; St. Andrew, St. Paul; St. Francis, Buffalo; St. John the Baptist, Jordan; St. Matthew, St. Paul; St. Peter, Hokah; St. John, Vermillion; St. Joseph, Red Wing; Silver Lake Catholic School, Silver Lake; St. Peter and Paul, Loretto; and Mankato Area Catholic Schools, Mankato. Since 1998, Sister Petrann has been serving as a ceramist at Ceramic Haven, Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota.
