Sister Mary Angeleen Brill, SSND

First Profession - August 6, 1948 | Celebrating 75 Years



Sister Mary Angeleen Brill was born in Appleton, Wisconsin, and began teaching in 1946, at St. Alphonsus, Chicago. In 1948, she professed first vows in Milwaukee. She continued teaching at St. Alphonsus until 1956, and then went to St. Paul in Chicago where she taught for eight years. While teaching at St. Paul, Sister Mary Angeleen received a bachelor's degree in education from Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee. Starting in 1964, she taught in Wisconsin schools for 32 years, including St. John Nepomucene, Prairie du Chien; St. George, Kenosha; and St. Mary, Port Washington. In 1971, she received a master's degree in elementary education from DePaul University in Chicago. Beginning in 1996, she spent the next eight years tutoring at St. Mary in Elm Grove, Wisconsin. From 1996 to 1998, she was a volunteer at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove. Since 2004, Sister Mary Angeleen has served in prayer and presence, first at Notre Dame of Elm Grove and currently, at Our Lady of the Angels, Greenfield, Wisconsin.
