SISTER ANN MARIE BONVIE, SSND

Sister Ann Marie Bonvie was born in Stellarton, Nova Scotia, Canada, and moved to Breese, Illinois in 1959. She received a bachelor's degree in education and social studies from Illinois State University, Normal, Illinois in 1970 and taught in St. Rose, Illinois for 11 years before entering SSND. She professed first vows in St. Louis, in 1984. That same year, she went to Loose Creek, Missouri, where she served as an administrator of elementary education at Immaculate Conception. In 1988, Sister Ann Marie received a master's degree in elementary educational administration from Dayton University, Dayton, Ohio. She remained in Loose Creek, Missouri, for three years and then went to the Diocese of Jefferson City Religious Education Office, Jefferson City, Missouri, where she was a consultant for religious education (1988-91). She then served as Superintendent of Schools for the Diocese of Jefferson City, Jefferson City, Missouri (1991-99). Sister Ann Marie then went to St. Augustine School, Belleville, Illinois, serving as an administrator of elementary education (1999-2005). From 2005-2007, she was a strategic planning consultant in Belleville. She served as an administrative assistant to the Provincial Council in St. Louis (2007-08). Sister Ann Marie then became the Director of Notre Dame Preschool in St. Louis serving until 2013. Since 2015, Sister Ann Marie has worked as a hospice chaplain for SSM Home Care/Hospice in Lake St. Louis, Missouri. Throughout her many years of service, she has dedicated herself to education and pastoral care.
