SISTER DANNEL WEDEMEYER, SSND

Sister Dannel Wedemeyer was born in St. Louis, Missouri and professed first vows in 1964 in St. Louis. She taught primary grades at the following schools: St. Francis Solanus, Quincy, Illinois (1964-70); St. Raphael, St. Louis (1970-72); and Blessed Sacrament, Belleville, Illinois (1972-75). In 1973, Sister Dannel received a Bachelor of Arts in education from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. She continued teaching at St. Joseph, East St. Louis, Illinois (1975-77); and then at Immaculate Conception, Dardenne, Missouri (1977-85). She served as coordinator of transportation at Villa Gesu, St. Louis (1985-94); before returning to the classroom as an elementary teacher at St. Bernard Indian Mission in Fort Yates, North Dakota (1994-2010). She then worked in records management at Red Cloud Indian Mission School, Pine Ridge, South Dakota (2011-13); and as an office manager at Red Cloud High School, Pine Ridge, South Dakota (2013-16); and then as an office assistant to the director of human resources at Red Cloud Mission, also in Pine Ridge (2016). Sister Dannel has dedicated herself to volunteer service at Sancta Maria in Ripa, St. Louis, and lives in prayer and presence in St. Louis.
