SISTER JUDITH ANN HEROLD, SSND

Sister Judith Ann Herold was born in Fort Madison, Iowa, and professed first vows in 1964 in St. Louis. That same year, she began studies at the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis, earning a Bachelor of Arts in American studies in 1965. Sister Judith Ann then spent the next 23 years teaching in Nebraska, Missouri and Illinois. She taught elementary school at Immaculate Conception School, Jackson, Missouri (1965-71); middle school at Sacred Heart School in Lawrence, Nebraska (1971-74); St. Joseph, Cairo, Illinois (1974-82); and junior high school at St. Teresa, Belleville, Illinois (1983-88). During this time, Sister Judith Ann earned a Master of Arts in elementary education from Southeast Missouri State University, Cape Girardeau, Missouri in 1977. Sister Judith Ann then served as administrator of religious education at St. Ambrose School in Godfrey, Illinois (1989-96). She then spent 11 years as coordinator of adult faith formation for various Catholic Churches in Fort Madison, Iowa (1996-2007). In 2007, she served as a pastoral associate at St. Anthony Parish in Davenport, Iowa, transitioning to part-time in 2015, where she remained until 2017. In 2017, she began volunteering at various areas in Davenport, Iowa, before returning to St. Louis, in 2021. Since 2021, Sister Judith Ann has dedicated herself to prayer and presence, first in St. Louis, and now at The Sarah Community, Bridgeton, Missouri.
