SISTER DOROTHY EGGERING, SSND

Sister Dorothy Eggering was born in St. Louis, and professed first vows there in 1954. She earned a Bachelor of Science in natural science and mathematics from the former Notre Dame College, St. Louis, in 1956. Sister Dorothy then taught high school at St. Joseph School, Conway, Arkansas (1956-63); St. Mary of the Pines, Chatawa, Mississippi (1963-68); Thomas K. Gorman High School, Tyler, Texas (1968-69); Redemptorist Senior High School, Baton Rouge, Louisiana (1969-75); Immaculate Conception School, Marrero, Louisiana (1975-79); and Thomas K. Gorman High School, Tyler, Texas (1979-80). She earned a Master of Science in chemistry from the University of Notre Dame, South Bend, Indiana, in 1965 and a Master of Arts in theology from St. Mary's University, San Antonio, Texas, in 1979. Sister Dorothy engaged in pastoral ministry at St. Michael Church, Bedford, Texas, from 1980-1992 before becoming pastoral administrator at Good Shepherd Parish, Colleyville, Texas from 1992-2007. After sabbatical study in 2008, she earned a Master of Christian Spirituality in counseling. Sister Dorothy then worked for the Diocese of Dallas, Dallas, as a liturgy office assistant (2009-16); and providing spiritual direction (2009-16). Currently, Sister Dorothy continues to provide spiritual direction and spiritual direction training in Bedford, Texas, where she currently resides.
