SISTER LUCILLE DEHEN, SSND

Sister Lucille Dehen was born in St. Paul, Minnesota, and professed first vows in 1954 in Mankato, Minnesota. She earned a Bachelor of Arts in elementary education from the College of St. Catherine in St. Paul, Minnesota in 1963. Sister Lucille taught primary grades at several schools in Minnesota, including St. Martin School in Rogers (1955-60); St. Anne School in Wabasso (1960-63); St. Felix School in Wabasha (1963-68); and St. Bartholomew School in Wayzata (1968-69). She also taught first grade at St. Wenceslaus School in Dickinson, North Dakota (1969-70); and later at St. Andrew School in St. Paul, Minnesota (1970-73; 1977-81). Sister Lucille served as an elementary school administrator at St. Bernard School in Cologne, Minnesota (1973-77); and at Guardian Angel-St. Boniface School in Colton, Washington (1984-91). She was also the principal of Trinity School in Spokane, Washington from 1981-1984. Sister Lucille earned a Master of Arts in elementary administration from Gonzaga University in Spokane, Washington in 1983. Sister Lucille held administrative roles at St. John-St. Andrew School in Greenwald, Minnesota (1991-94) and Good Counsel Learning Center, Mankato, Minnesota (1994-2005). She also tutored students at schools in Mankato, Minnesota (2006-10; 2018-19). Sister Lucille then traveled to Hungary, and taught English at St. Stephen Schools, Mako (2010-11). Upon her return to the United States, she began serving at Good Counsel Learning Center, Mankato, Minnesota, in a variety of roles: as technology staff (2006-10); tutor (2006-18); and librarian (2018-19). Currently Sister Lucille is serving in prayer and presence in Shakopee, Minnesota.
