SISTER MARGUERITE DE MOTT, SSND

Sister Marguerite De Mott was born in De Tour, Michigan, and professed first vows in 1954 in Milwaukee. She earned a Bachelor of Science in education, with a minor in social science at Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee, in 1961. Sister Marguerite dedicated her career to teaching. She taught at the following schools in Wisconsin: St. Michael School, Milwaukee (1954-59); Our Lady of Peace, Marshfield (1959-63); Sacred Heart, Grand Rapids (1963-64); St. Mary, Greenville (1964-65); St. Patrick, Menasha (1965-66); St. Dominic, Brookfield (1966-71); St. James, Mukwonago (1971-72); Immaculate Heart of Mary, West Allis (1972-74; 1976-78); and St. Philip, Rudolph (1974-76). Sister Marguerite also taught at St. Joseph School in Oconto, Wisconsin (1978-79) and Freeport, Illinois (1979-80), where she also engaged in pastoral ministry, (1979-80). She continued at St. Joseph School in Freeport, Illinois, teaching there until 1985. She then worked at Notre Dame Health Care Center, Elm Grove, Wisconsin, serving as an occupational therapy aid for one year. Sister Marguerite taught elementary school at St. Helen School in Milwaukee (1986-98); St. Josaphat and Nativity Jesuit Middle School, both in Milwaukee, until retirement in 2001. Sister Marguerite then began volunteering as a tutor and resource person for St. Josaphat, Milwaukee (2001-11). Since 2021, Sister Marguerite has been serving in prayer and presence in Milwaukee, where she currently resides.
