SISTER MARY GEN OLIN, SSND

Sister Mary Gen Olin was born in Plainview, Minnesota, and professed first vows in 1954 in Mankato, Minnesota. She earned a Bachelor of Arts in English and social science from College of St. Catherine (now University) in St. Paul, in 1956 and a Master of Arts in geography from St. Louis University, St. Louis, in 1967. Sister Mary Gen taught at Notre Dame High School, Cresco, Iowa (1954-55); and at St. Agnes School in St. Paul, (1955-60). She later taught junior high school in North Dakota; St. Anne School in Bismarck (1960-61); and St. Benedict School in Strasburg (1961-63). Sister Mary Gen served as an administrator at St. Bartholomew School in Wayzata, Minnesota, from 1963-1967. Sister Mary Gen then became supervisor of SSND Schools for the former Mankato Province, Mankato, Minnesota (1967-71); transitioning to administrator at Lonsdale-New Market-Veseli School, Lonsdale, Minnesota (1972-73). She then became an education consultant in the Archdiocese of St. Paul/Minneapolis, St. Paul (1973-75). In 1975, Sister Mary Gen became superintendent of schools for the Diocese of New Ulm, New Ulm, Minnesota (1975-83); and then for the Archdiocese of St. Paul/Minneapolis (1984-87). Sister Mary Gen served as provincial leader for the former Mankato Province (now Central Pacific Province), Mankato, Minnesota, from 1987-1995. Sister Mary Gen ministered in Kenya serving as a teacher at Christ the Teacher Institute, Kisii, Kenya (1997-98); administrator at St. Theresa's Girls' Secondary School, Kisii, Kenya (1997-98); director of temporary professed sisters at Catholic Mission, Kiptere, Kenya (1999-2003); and headmistress at St. Francis Girls Secondary School, Kiptere, Kenya (2002-04). Upon her return from Kenya, she served as a development advisor for the former Mankato Province (now Central Pacific Province), in Mankato, Minnesota (2004-07); and then the coordinator of hospitality at Notre Dame Center, St. Paul (2007-18). Since 2018, she has been engaged in community service and prayer and presence at Our Lady of Good Counsel, Mankato, Minnesota, and now in Shakopee, Minnesota.
