Sister Patricia Miller was born in New Orleans, and professed first vows in 1954 in St. Louis. She taught primary and junior high students at Our Lady of Prompt Succor School in Chalmette, Louisiana (1954-62); and junior high at Christ the King School, Corpus Christi, Texas (1962-65). In 1964, she received a Bachelor of Arts in music education with a focus on piano from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. Sister Patricia taught music at St. Gregory Nongraded School in Tyler, Texas (1965-69); serving as administrator there from 1969-71. She earned a Master of Arts in theology from St. Mary's University in San Antonio, in 1972. Sister Patricia engaged in pastoral ministry at Immaculate Conception Church in Denton, Texas (1971-77). She then was the program director for ministry programs for the Diocese of Fort Worth, Fort Worth, Texas (1977-90). Sister Patricia then served as co-director of ministries outreach at the Catholic Renewal Center, Fort Worth, Texas, (2003-17). After retirement, she dedicated herself to community service and prayer and presence at St. Mary of the Pines, Chatawa, Mississippi (2017-19). She is now serving in prayer and presence in Covington, Louisiana.
