SISTER RITA CLARE SWENARSKI, SSND

Sister Rita Clare Swenarski was born in Milwaukee, and professed first vows in 1954 in Milwaukee. She was a teacher at St. Adalbert School, Grand Rapids, Michigan (1955-66). Sister Rita Clare earned a Bachelor of Science in education and English at Mount Mary College (now University) in Milwaukee, in 1962. She then taught at St. Casimir School, Milwaukee (1966-69); while earning a Master of Education in guidance counseling from Marquette University, Milwaukee, in 1970. Sister Rita Clare served as an elementary school principal and full time Grade 8 teacher at St. Casimir School in Milwaukee (1970-76); St. Mary School in Elm Grove, Wisconsin (1976-86); principal and religious educator at St. Bruno School and Parish, Dousman, Wisconsin (1986-87); and principal at Montini Catholic School, McHenry, Illinois (1987-89). Sister Rita Clare returned to the classroom as a teacher at Holy Assumption School in West Allis, Wisconsin (1989-94); briefly returning to serving as principal at Our Lady Queen of Peace School, Milwaukee (1994-96); then returning to the classroom as a junior high teacher at St. Alexander School in Milwaukee (1996-2002); and at Blessed Sacrament School in Milwaukee (2002-08). Sister Rita Clare then tutored students in literacy, GED preparation, and English as a Second Language at Milwaukee Achiever Literacy Service, Milwaukee (2008-22); and at Cristo Rey Jesuit High School (2017-21). Sister Rita Clare currently serves in prayer and presence in at Trinity Woods, Milwaukee.
