SISTER ARLINE JAEGER, SSND

Sister Arline Jaeger was born in Milwaukee and professed first vows there in 1949. She taught elementary students and served as a musician at SS Peter & Paul School, Gary, Indiana (1949-51); and then taught middle school and junior high students at Holy Redeemer School, Madison, Wisconsin (1951-58), and junior high school at St. Aloysius School, Arcadia, Wisconsin (1958-63). Sister Arline earned a Bachelor of Science in education at Mount Mary College (now University), Milwaukee in 1959. She also worked as an organist and administrator at St. Aloysius School, Arcadia, Wisconsin (1963-68). Sister Arline taught music and served in administration at St. Jerome School, Oconomowoc, Wisconsin (1968-69). She taught at Holy Cross School, Milwaukee (1969-71) and Holy Assumption School, West Allis, Wisconsin (1971-73). In 1973, Sister Arline again served dual roles as a teacher and administrator at Mary Queen of Heaven School, West Allis, Wisconsin, until 1983. She finished her teaching career at Christ the King School, Wauwatosa, Wisconsin (1983-85), and St. Mary Help of Christians School, West Allis, Wisconsin (1985-86). From 1986-1998, she worked at Tyme Out retreat centers in Pewaukee, Wisconsin, while caring for her parent. Sister Arline then volunteered at Havenwood Nursing and Rehab Center, Milwaukee (2003-04), and Milwaukee Achiever Literacy Services, Milwaukee (2003-20). Since 2020, Sister Arline has been serving in prayer and presence, first at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, Elm Grove, Wisconsin, and then at Trinity Woods, Milwaukee.
