SISTER MARY DORA KIPP, SSND

**Sister Dora Kipp** was born in Marshfield, Wisconsin, and professed first vows in 1949 in Milwaukee. Sister Dora taught primary students at St. Anne School in Milwaukee (1949-63) earning a Bachelor of Arts in history and English from Mount Mary College, (now University) in Milwaukee in 1956. She taught at St. Kilian School in Campbellsport, Wisconsin (1963-65); and served in dual teaching and administration roles at St. Mary School in Glen Haven, Wisconsin (1965-72). Sister Dora earned a Master of Science in administration of elementary education from the University of Wisconsin-Madison, Madison, Wisconsin, in 1969. She continued working in a dual role as an administrator and teacher at St. Leonard School in Muskego, Wisconsin (1972-77). Sister Dora Kipp served as a local leader at Visitation Convent in Elm Grove, Wisconsin (1977-85); before caring for her parents and teaching part-time at Sacred Heart School in Marshfield, Wisconsin, from 1985-91. Sister Dora returned to primary teaching at Sacred Heart in Marshfield from 1991-93. In 1993, she became a local leader again, this time at Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Mount Calvary, Wisconsin, serving there until 2000. In 2001, she became a substitute teacher at various schools throughout Marshfield and served as the coordinator of religious education at St. Michael, Hewitt, Wisconsin, until 2016. From 2015-18, Sister Dora served as a volunteer at Cedar Rail Court, Marshfield, Wisconsin. Sister Dora then dedicated herself to prayer, presence and service at Notre Dame of Elm Grove, followed by Trinity Woods, Milwaukee.
