Sister William Ann Heidenfelder was born in St. Louis and professed first vows there in 1949. She began her ministry teaching at St. Michael, Radom, Illinois (1949-52), and then St. Joseph, Farmington, Missouri (1952-64). In 1960, Sister William Ann received a Bachelor of Arts in art from the former Notre Dame College in St. Louis. She then spent the next 30 years teaching at schools throughout Missouri: St. John Nepomuk, St. Louis (1965-69); Blessed Sacrament, Hannibal, Missouri (1969-71); and St. Barbara, St. Louis (1971-72); St. Engelbert, St. Louis (1972-76); Compton Hights Catholic School, St. Louis (1976-79); and St. Martin of Tours, St. Louis (1979-86). Sister William Ann then dedicated herself to ministry to the elderly at All Souls, St. Louis (1986-2006). She then spent 16 years continuing to serve the elderly in the St. Louis area until 2022. Currently, Sister William Ann continues to serve her community in prayer, presence and service in Bridgeton, Missouri.
