In her six years at Saint Louis Zoo, Wanda has also been active in the Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) Green Scientific Advisory Group, serving as Chair from 2014-2018. In her role as Chair, Wanda led a 3-year Action Planning effort which identified the creation of a sustainability course for AZA professionals as a top priority.

Her academic background intersects the human and built environment with Master’s degree in Urban Planning and Real Estate Development from Saint Louis University coupled with social sciences (Sociology & Anthropology) undergraduate degrees from Indiana University.
