Stacy Murphy District Chief St. Paul Police Department

Stacy Murphy is currently the District Chief for the Western District at the Saint Paul Police Department. She has been with the Saint Paul Police Department for over 21 years. District Chief Murphy has worked in patrol, investigations, community engagement, administration, and numerous other roles throughout her career. She was selected as a member of the Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team as a patrol officer and was the only woman on the team at that time. During her time with the Saint Paul Police Department, Stacy has risen through the ranks to her current position as the District Chief, running the Western District's day-to-day operations and supervising over 100 sworn employees.

This summer, District Chief Murphy will be attending the FBI National Academy, which is a 10-week course in Quantico, Virginia for leaders in the law enforcement community. Less than 1% of law enforcement personnel worldwide have the opportunity to attend this specific training.

Stacy enjoys being physically active and spending time outdoors, especially going for hikes with her dog, Laki. She will be participating in the 2024 Twin Cities Marathon by taking part in the 10-mile run.


